Resources - incl. for grief & trauma



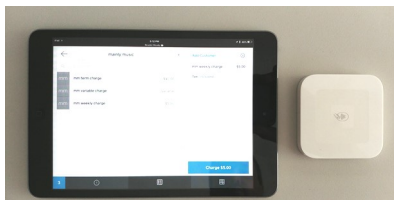
We have several resources for borrowing - including some that help families deal with grief and trauma in its various forms.

The Marriage Course is a series of seven sessions, designed to help couples invest in their relationship and build a strong marriage. The course will help you to:

- Recognise how your upbringing affects your relationship
- Improve relationships with parents and in-laws
- Develop greater sexual intimacy
