## What's all this?

Church Council recognises the need to spend more time on spiritual oversight and pastoral care, and less on the operational issues associated with running the church.

## What's The Jethro Project?

In Exodus 18 we read that Moses was overwhelmed by the number of decisions to be made and was counselled by his father-in-law, Jethro, to appoint a group of people to manage the day-to-day issues of the nation of Israel. In a similar vein, *The Jethro Project* aims to implement a new structure whereby Church Council delegates much of the operational side of things (eg. property maintenance, workplace health & safety and duty of care) to an Administration Sub-Committee.

Church Council have formed a team comprising Katherine Economides, Amanda Stewart and Rick Seaman, as well as Craig Bailey (Director of Leadership at Uniting College) to guide the process of moving to this new structure. It is planned that this process will take 6 months.

There are five steps planned; we are currently in the Discovery phase.
