The SaiYaRak group, living in villages near Pua, in Nan Province, North Eastern Thailand continue to be affected by COVID although I haven't heard of any of them being personally infected. They have continued to support one another and help the students and families with expenses and food. The young ones who are working are assisting their mothers as they are able. The antiretroviral drugs continue to help those living with HIV.


The group continues to purchase bulk rice at harvest time (October) when it is a low price which sees them through the year and some of the women continue to support their families with projects of raising fish, frogs and chickens, crocheting fish nets to sell, sewing and weaving as they are able.

The ongoing assistance helps the group and their support of the continuing students – Dem Derm Primary school, Dream & Oom at Secondary School and Gift, Nook, Copy & Oy doing Tertiary studies.
