Being available for occasional babysitting to allow parents to get out together, eg. for the Parenting and Marriage Courses.

## Persian Ministry

### Serving our Persian brothers and sisters.

**Detention Visitation**

Visiting people in the Immigration detention facility at Kilburn.

**Refugee Advocates**

Liaising with lawyers, supporting refugees through tribunal hearings, lobbying government.

**Creative Threads (connecting through craft)**

Connecting women of the church with Persian women; to teach them a craft or skill; to aid in their feelings of belonging and to help them improve their English with regular contact with English speakers.

**Sunday Morning Persian Teaching**

Being willing to teach our Persian believers from time to time during the Sunday morning service.

**Preaching at Emmanuel Church at North Plympton**

English speaking preachers (seeking one per month) .

## Connecting together

### Serving with practical support and care

You can select multiple options.

**Bread Run**

Distributing leftover bread from local bakeries to Hutt Street and other charities.

**Drivers**

Helping transport people to places like doctors' appointments, worship services, youth group events, Creative Threads etc.

*Note: must be willing to undergo DHS screening*

**Help with Funerals, Weddings and Special Services**

Helping organise the church for special events, assist during the events and ensure the church is ready again for our Sunday worship gathering (see also 'Weddings & Funerals').

**Home Help**

Offering your own, or your Life Group's services, to assist in the home (eg. odd jobs, washing, ironing etc.) and garden to people who have a need within the church and community.

*Note: must be willing to undergo DHS screening*

**Meal preparation**

Providing and distributing meals to people who are in need within the church and community.

**Men's/Women's Ministry**

Helping organise various Men's & Women's events (eg. Bloom for women, men's breakfasts etc.)

**Pastoral Visiting****Social Events Team**

Getting the church together for social activities like church picnics or quiz nights etc. An important ministry that helps us to know and have fun with each other.

**Welcome Team**

Looking out for newcomers and/or providing hospitality like hosting an occasional lunch for newcomers.

## Mission Related Activities

### Serving in the global mission of the church

You can select multiple options.

**Mission Care**

Caring for our mission workers in prayer, practical assistance and correspondence, and through support groups. This includes Saiyarak HIV/AIDS group in Thailand and ministry to people of other cultures living in Adelaide.

**Project Dorcas - Craft with a purpose**

Helping to make quality goods for children in need.

---

**Serving around the Church Grounds and in the Office**

You can select multiple options.

**Flowers**

Preparing/arranging the flowers at the front of the church.

**Gardening**

Maintenance and upkeep of the garden beds (weeding, mulching, planting and irrigation).  
A Life Group could 'adopt' an area of the church.

**Grounds Maintenance**

Maintenance of the hard-surface (eg. car parks, paths etc), scrub and grassed areas.

**Mid-week Office Helper**

Helping the church office with various projects and tasks including photocopying, tidying church/kitchen, preparing newsheets/handouts etc. Experience with computers helpful but not essential.

**Occasional office jobs to be done at home**

Short term projects, admin jobs (computer work)

**Property Maintenance**

General maintenance of our church property (odd jobs from time to time).

Being part of our Alpha organising team.

Being part of a team serving local young families, eg. helping in the kitchen, baking for the session, setting/cleaning up etc.
