Child Safety

As we start a new year we wanted to remind you of some important ways we can keep our children safe.

Stage Area Please remember to keep your kids off the front stage area during and after the mainly music session. We don't want them to pull anything onto themselves.



Slamming Doors The doors between the two rooms in the chapel as well as the outside door (to the ramp) are able to be secured so they don't slam shut in the wind, potentially injuring a young child.

Escaping Kids Please ensure that the external foyer doors are closed behind you when head back home after mainly music. We have a few toddlers who love to escape... thank you for your help!

Hot Drinks Please ensure that you keep the lids on your drinks so as to avoid any scalding. Our drinks are all served at a comfortable drinking temperature of approx 60°C.
